**Another Girl
Missing from
Wellesley Home**

WELLESLEY, Mass. AP—Penelope [Penelope] Plotze, 19, blonde college student [student], was reported missing today by her parents who said the girl had left Marblehead yesterday to bicycle home.

A second-year student at Bouve-Boston, where she is majoring in physical therapy, the girl had been working for the summer at the Eastern Yacht Club at Marblehead [Marblhead].

The girl's father, Herman, talked with her yesterday by telephone at 3 p.m. She was reported seen passing through Lynn about 4:30 p.m. She is 5 feet, 8 inches tall, weighs 150 pounds and has light blonde hair.

Penelope is the second college girl from Wellesley to disappear in a week. Earlier, Sylvia Plath, 20, a Smith student, was the object of a wide search. She was found in the basement of her home, victim [victim] of an overdose of sleeping pills. She is reported in good condition [condition] in Newton-Wellesley Hospital [Hospital].
