She left a note at her home stating she was going for a walk. Her favorite spots for walking are the Public Garden and the Esplanade along the Charles River where police of the Back Bay and Joy st. stations went to look for her.

Miss Plath was to re-enter Smith in the fall as a senior. She topped her junior class. Her mother said she has been under a doctor's care for a nervous condition [condition].

She is five feet nine inches tall and weighs 140 pounds. Her hair is dark brown and her eyes are brown. She was wearing a light blue skirt and white sleeveless [sleeveless] blouse when she left home.
