Want Separate Gym Turning to the subject of gymnasium and auditorium, the joint board agreed that a combined gym-auditorium is not satisfactory.

They also discarded a suggestion from an interested citizen who had observed that the school planned for the Dickinson Street lot, might be built without auditorium, and the present high school auditorium continued in use.

Among the suggestions heard on the auditorium, in comparison to the present school auditorium, were that it should have a stage large enough to hold more than a small "pew-wow," as one member stated it, and that it be available for extensive use by public groups.

Deliberating on the size of the gymnasium, the board made no definite decision other than that the seating capacity should be at least 1,000 to 1,200, and that in cognizance of an adequate physical program it should have room for four separate classes.

Several members expressed themselves in favor of a separate "corrective" room as part of the physical facilities and there were no dissenting voices on the question.

The board also expressed the opinion that both gym and auditorium should be included as part of the school building, but so arranged that they would have common toilet facilities, and would allow sports crowds and other gatherings to attend without traveling through the school proper.

The board considered the possibility that the vocational school might be set up in a building separate from the high school and emphatically vetoed the idea on the grounds that it would mean extra cost in construction and maintenance, it would increase administrative difficulties, would cause unnecessary interference in the scheduling of academic work for vocational students, and just as important would further damage the relations of the various student groups.

### Farm Education, Research Key to Problem--Benson

WASHINGTON — Secretary of Agriculture Benson said yesterday that research and education holds the key to the major farm problems, which he listed as reducing costs, improving quality and expanding markets.

Asking the major farm organizations to give him the benefit of their views on farm problems, Benson said: "We must think of the entire job, from the test tube right on through to the complicated business of running a farm and distributing farm products."

"If we are to look forward to continuing progress, it is necessary to provide more adequately for research in those fundamental sciences upon which all of agriculture rests."

"This is the source of new principles for the further improvement of our soils, plants and livestock."

The report said that lawyers well known for their anti-Communist views in several recent cases involving Communist or persons accused of being Communists, which they took out of a sense of public duty, have been subjected to severe personal vilification and abuse.

The report also recalled that a leading lawyer assigned by the court to represent a Nazi during the war "was spat at in the courtroom."

Another, it said, was attacked editorially "for undertaking to represent an alleged racketeer in a trial involving grave constitutional questions."

On the ABA's program today was an important afternoon speech by Secretary of State Dulles on the treaty making power in foreign policy.

In another address prepared for the assembly, President Andre Taschereau of the Canadian Bar Association assailed what he termed widespread impatience with established laws. He said administrative boards and labor laws were threatening freedoms by passing court or interfering with rights of contract.

Department of Justice officials at the convention were slow to comment on a resolution adopted yesterday that lawyers who are Communists should be removed from practice by federal and state officials.

The lawyers heard a charge yesterday from U. S. Senator Bricker rights to justice abroad had been sacrificed on the altar of international co-operation by the recently approved NATO status of forces treaty. He said it would be "difficult if not impossible" to protect service men's fundamental rights under the treaty.

### She'll Flee U. S. If Government Seizes Her Home

BOSTON, (U. S. — Mrs. Ida Hedin, 66-year-old widow, says she'll go to Sweden on a refugee passport if the government succeeds in seizing her home to make way for an 11 million dollar quartermaster research laboratory.

Federal Judge George C. Sweeney yesterday gave Mrs. Hedin's lawyer until Friday to file briefs in the eminent domain proceedings in connection with the woman's Natick home.

After the judge's action, Mrs. Hedin said: "If I don't win, I will positively apply for a refugee passport. If that happens, this country is taking another step toward Communism. That's the way they do it in Russia."

Mrs. Hedin contends the government does not want her property for "public use" but rather for housing purposes.

THOMASTON, Maine (U. S. — Edward Graffam, 77, for 52 years a Maine State Prison inmate, looked forward today to a quiet, peaceful life.

Graffam, the prison's oldest inmate, was freed yesterday under a new state law permitting parole for lifers who have served at least 30 years.

Convicted of murder during a robbery—a crime he still denies committing—Graffam will work as a cook for two prison guards who maintain bachelor quarters.

"I've hoped and prayed for this day a great many years," he said.
