**Missing Smith  
Student Found**

WELLESLEY, Mass. (INS) – A brilliant 20-year-old Smith College [College] Senior today was recovering from an overdose of sleeping pills as police sought to determine if she spent the two days she was missing in a tiny cellar recess of her home.

Sylvia Plath, honor student and literary contributor to national magazines, was discovered lying behind a pile of kindling wood on a narrow ledge between the basement [basement] and a porch of her home. Beside her was found a water container and eight sleeping pills in a bottle which originally contained [contained] 50 tablets.

Police admitted it was possible she might have been in the cellar throughout the search for her. However, they pointed out that when she was found she was wearing [wearing] different clothing than she wore when she was last seen.
