Missing Girl Found

Smith Student Discovered Under Porch of Wellesley Home

Wellesley, Mass.—(AP)—A 20-year-old Smith college senior—who vanished Monday after telling [telling] her mother she was going hiking [hiking]—was found yesterday semi-conscious but apparently uninjured [uninjured] under the porch of her home.

While searchers fanned out in a widespread search, Sylvia Plath was located by her brother, Warren [Warren], 18, and her grandmother, Mrs. Aurelia Schobar, 66, who heard moaning coming from the cellar of their home.

Police Chief Robert McVey said an empty water jar and a container [container] of eight sleeping tablets were found by the girl's side. He

said the bottle had contained 48 tablets when full.

Her mother, Mrs. Aurelia S. Plath, a Boston University professor [professor], said her daughter recently had been depressed.
