### **Student at Smith Reported Missing**

Wellesley, Aug. 24 (AP)—A Smith College honor student was reported missing tonight by her mother, a Boston University professor.

Mrs. Aurelia S. Plath told police her daughter, Sylvia, 20, left home early in the afternoon after writing [writing] a note she was "going for a hike" and would return tomorrow [tomorrow].

Mrs. Plath said that her daughter [daughter] has been "nervous" and under a doctor's care for several months.

The girl, who is scheduled to enter [enter] her senior year at Smith College [college] next month, has sold short stories and poems to magazines. As a college junior, she was editor of the *Smith Review*, the college literary magazines, and a member of the school's press board.
