Girl Poet Found In Coma Condition

ELLESLEY, MASS. – (UP) –
Sylvia Plath, brilliant poetry-writing [poetry-writing] Smith College girl who had been the object of an intense search since Monday, was found unconscious in the cellar of her home Wednesday.

The 20 year old student was found in a partially-excavated portion [portion] of the cellar by her brother, Warren, 18. Beside her was an empty bottle which had contained 50 sleeping pills.

At Newton-Wellesley Hospital, her condition was described as "fairly good." The hospital bulletin [bulletin] said she had a slight bruise on her face and was "semi-comatose and moaning."
