**Co-ed Recovers
From Overdose**

Wellesley, Mass. (AP)—Miss Sylvia Plath, 20-year-old Smith College student discovered in the cellar of her home Wednesday after a 40-hour police search, was reported in good condition at Wellesley-Newton Hospital yesterday [yesterday]. She is recovering from an overdose of sleeping tablets.

The girl was found lying in a cellar-like recess beneath the porch of her home hidden by a pile of kindling wood.

An empty water jar and a bottle [bottle] containing eight sleeping pills was found by her side. The bottle had contained 48 pills, police said, when it was taken from the home.
