Wellesley Girl Found In Her Home

WELLESLEY (UP) – Miss Sylvia Plath, 20, missing Smith College honor student, was found in the cellar of her home here today as an organized [organized] search for her was pressed by police and volunteers [volunteers].

The girl, who was found by her brother, Warren, was taken to Newton-Wellesley Hospital.

Miss Plath had disappeared Monday, leaving a note in which she said she was "taking a long walk—be back tomorrow."

Her mother, Mrs. Aurelia Plath, said the girl had been under a doctor's care for nervous exhaustion.

Police said Miss Plath had taken 40 of 50 sleeping pills she had when she disappeared [disappeared]. She was reported in critical condition.
