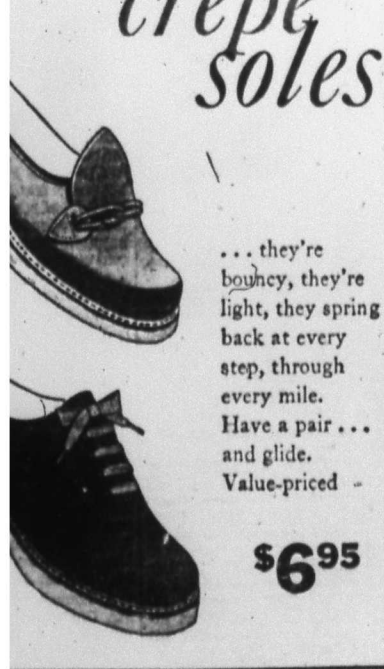

4500-Mile Hop, Non-Stop, to Be A-Planes' Goal

TAMPA, Fla. (AP)—Forty-five planes—part of the atomic striking arm of the Air Force—will take off early in September on the longest non-stop mass flight ever attempted by jet bombers.

The Air Force announced that the 306th Bombardment Wing, which has been in England for 90 days of training exercises, will try a non-stop flight from its training base at Fairford, England, to the MacDill Air Force Base here—a distance of about 4500 miles.

The wing consists of 45 B-47 medium jet bombers. They will be refueled in flight by KC-97 Stratotankers.
