**Missing College Girl
Found Under Porch**

WELLESLEY, Mass., Aug. 27,
— (AP)—A pretty 20-year-old Smith
College senior, who vanished
Monday after telling her mother
she was going hiking, was found
semiconscious but apparently un-
injured [uninjured] under the porch
of her home.

While searchers fanned out,
Sylvia Plath was located by her
brother, Warren, 18, and her
grandmother, Mrs. Aurelia Scho-
bar [Schobar], who heard moaning.

A nearby empty container of
sleeping tablets was by the girl's
side. Mrs. Aurelia S. Plath said
her daughter had been depressed
because "for some time she had
been unable to write either fiction
or poetry."
