WELLESLEY, Mass., Aug. 25 (AP)
Volunteer searchers and a bloodhound [bloodhound] scoured woods and lake shores Tuesday for a brilliant, 20-year-old Smith college girl who disappeared [disappeared] after leaving a note saying [saying], "I'm going for a walk."

Sylvia Plath, a college senior and daughter of a Boston university professor, left her home Monday after writing that she'd return today.

Her mother, Mrs. Aurelia S. Plath, told police the girl has been "nervous" and under a physician's care for several months. State police [police] said a bottle of 50 sleeping pills was missing from the girl's room and it is believed she took them with her.
